Dear Mr Mikami:

I trust that you will have received my cable of the 22nd. Mr. Shibusawa's and my letter is to confirm our invitation for you and your consultant's visit to Bangkok. I have contacted a sponsor over here and the party concerned agrees to our proposal. The details, of course, we will discuss on your arrival. It is understood that all expenses for you and your consultant's passage and stay in Bangkok will be paid for by us.

It is also understood that contacts between the sponsor over here and your good self will have Mr Shibusawa and myself as intermediaries. I will hold myself personally responsible for matters being settled satisfactorily to all parties concerned. If you agree to come please let Mr Shibusawa and myself know, and also Professor Sakakibara over there, in consideration of the fact that he was present at all our meetings and may have something further to say for our convenience.

We will be forwarding a separate invitation letter from myself and the sponsor for you to arrange your passport facilities. I wish to thank you personally for all the cooperation for our prospective combined project, what has already passed and what is yet to come. Looking forward to see you in Bangkok very soon.
