Dear Miss Hillyer:

I stopped in Bangkok the beginning of May and had occasion to meet Mr. Prasit Silpabanleg and discuss the future plans of the PHAKAJALAI DANCE COMPANY. I was informed that you are planning a U.S. tour in 1970 and plan to arrange appearances for the group en route through Europe.

My inquiry and interest is primarily directed in presenting the company in Japan, possibly during April 1970, for about three weeks and on their back or to U.S.A. to have them stop for appearances in Germany, Holland, Switzerland, Portugal, all depending which period will be made available to me.

I watched a performance and found some of the dances attractive and presume that before leaving on an extensive tour more male dancers will be added, the company well rehearsed and the lighting and well set.

Would you kindly advise me what their weekly conditions would be as well as their concert fee for spot arrangements en route.

It was a pleasure to learn about your activities from several sources while I was in Japan, including Mr. Walter Nichols, the Cultural Attache of the American Embassy in Tokyo who knows me quite well. I hope that I shall have the opportunity to meet you personally. I shall be stopping in New York, possibly in September, returning from Europe to Hong Kong. Kindly address your correspondence to Hong Kong from where it will be forwarded to me.
